

## Prosthetic Postop

☐ Immediate/Interim Denture/Partial

Immediate dentures may be quite uncomfortable for several weeks. They also require frequent adjustments and one or more permanent relines within several months. I understand that the costs associated with the reline are my responsibility. I understand that a new complete denture may be necessary after the first year and that the cost associated with this is my responsibility. Wash with antibacterial hand soap.

**\*Adjustments made before the final impression will NOT result in additional fees. \***

☐ Partial

You will have several appointments until we deliver your final partial. You will not move to the next step until both you and the doctor are satisfied with the results. Typical appointments:

1. Impressions for bite rim
2. Impressions to register bite
3. Framework try-in with or without teeth
4. Wax try-in
5. Delivery

**\*You can make changes to desired color, shape, size, etc. of the teeth or base of the partial prior to final fabrication. \***

☐ Complete Denture

You will have several appointments until we deliver your final denture. You will not move to the next step until both you and the doctor are satisfied with the results. Typical appointments:

1. Impressions for custom tray
2. Impressions to register bite
3. Wax try-in
4. Delivery

**\*You can make changes to desired color, shape, size, etc. of the teeth or base of the denture prior to final fabrication. \***

Wearing a partial/denture is not a simple process. Chewing efficiency will be diminished and partials/dentures are not permanent and will require periodic replacement. Sore spots, altered speech, and difficulty eating are common problems. You may have to return for periodic adjustments and failure to keep appointments may result in a less than desirable result.
